Short support description	The Clinical Trials Center (CTC) of the University Hospital Zurich supports all research teams of the University Hospital Zurich and University of Zurich associated hospitals in the planning and realization of clinical trial projects in compliance with the Swiss Human Research Act, its ordinances and local regulations, and the international Good Clinical Practice Standards (ICH-GCP). The CTC's services range from consulting over data management and monitoring to providing facilities (fully equipped clinical research ward for in- and out-patients), equipment, logistics and specialist personnel for the optimized conduct of clinical research projects (Phase I-IV). The CTC services are primarily offered to support academic and investigator-initiated clinical research but are also open to projects sponsored by the industry. The CTC is an approved and certified center for Continuing and Further Education for medical and non-medical professionals interested in clinical research.
